### The Importance of Identification, Assessment, Treatment, and Collaboration.

Human trafficking is a nationwide epidemic and Florida is ranked third in the nation. Our most vulnerable population is at risk for Human Trafficking and Commercial Sexual Exploitation: Children who are victims of abuse, experience violence in the home, reside in foster care, reside in poor neighborhoods, runaways, and unaccompanied minors/dependent immigrants. Judges, General Magistrates, and Attorneys are in a prime position to identify victims and respond to their needs effectively. This training will provide you with information on: Florida's Anti-Human Trafficking Laws, the indicators of human trafficking, the trauma behind the abuse, what steps to take if you suspect human trafficking, and the importance of collaboration to identify these victims. You will also hear from a Survivor of Human Trafficking.
