Put Something Back (PSB), Dade Legal Aid's pro bono program, serves as the official clearing-house for pro bono matters in Miami-Dade County. PSB matches private attorneys and law firms in Miami with qualifying clients who need assistance in a variety of civil legal matters.

The Project is spearheaded by Dade Legal Aid and utilizes talented and dynamic volunteers from diverse backgrounds to help facilitate clinics, workshops and case referrals.
