

If you believe you are the victim of discrimination by your employer or another on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, disability or marital status, you may file a complaint with the [Florida Commission on Human Relations](#), the [Equal Employment Opportunity Commission](#) OR contact the [American Civil Liberties Union](#). If you suspect discrimination, you should contact these agencies promptly to protect your legal rights. There are strict time limits within which charges must be filed.

You may also try contacting Dade Legal Aid [www.dadelegalaid.org](http://www.dadelegalaid.org) for a free interview and a possible referral to a pro bono attorney or another agency may be able to assist you. You may also contact the Dade County Bar Association Lawyer Referral Service (“LRS”). They will refer you to a private attorney for a consultation. The \$50 referral fee entitles you to a 30-minute consultation with an attorney who handles employment law cases. Any further legal work on your behalf would be subject to whatever fee you negotiate with the attorney.
