**FINAL JUDGMENT OF ADOPTION**

THIS CAUSE came to be heard before this court on \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_, for the final hearing on the Petitioners, BBB and CCC's Verified Joint Petition for Adoption, pursuant to the Florida Statutes, Chapter 63, and upon consideration and the evidence presented, the Court finds that:

1. This Court has subject matter and personal jurisdiction over this matter.
2. The Petitioners, BBB and CCC, desire the permanent responsibility of parents in this Adoption, and they are fit and proper people to adopt the minor child.
3. The minor child, AAA, a male who was born on \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_, is suitable for adoption by the Petitioners, BBB and CCC. There is no pending litigation regarding the minor child in the State of Florida or any other state, nor is there any other person not a party to these proceedings who has, or claims to have, physical custody or visitation rights to the minor child.
4. The best interest of the minor child, AAA, will be served and promoted by this adoption and the Petitioners, BBB and CCC, desire the permanent responsibility of parents in this adoption.
5. The Final Judgment of Termination of the Parental Rights as to the Mother and as to the Unmarried and Unknown Father has been entered and filed with this Court and are hereby incorporated by reference. No appeals were taken.
6. A Guardian Ad Litem was appointed and provided a Report of the Guardian Ad Litem to the Court.

7. The Guardian Ad Litem's Report has been filed with this Court and is hereby incorporated by reference.

8. The Guardian Ad Litem recommended that it is the minor child's best interest to be adopted by the Petitioners.

9. The Uniform Child Custody Jurisdiction and Enforcement Act (UCCJEA) Affidavit was filed with the court and is hereby incorporated by reference.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that:

10. The Court grants the Petitioners' Verified Petition for Adoption by BBB and CCC.

11. The minor child shall hereafter be known as AAA.

12. The minor child, AAA, born on \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, is declared to be the legal child of the Co-Petitioners, BBB and CCC.

13. The minor child shall be the child and legal heir at law of the Petitioners, BBB and CCC, and shall be entitled to all rights and privileges, and subject to all obligations of a child born to the Petitioners.

14. All legal relationships between the child and his birth/legal parents are hereby terminated by this adoption, as are all parental rights and responsibilities of the birth/legal parents. This Final Judgment of Adoption terminates all legal relationships between the child and the birth/legal parents, and this Final Judgment of Adoption creates a relationship between the child and the relatives of BBB and CCC that would have existed if the child was a blood descendant of BBB and CCC, born within wedlock. This relationship is hereby created for all purposes, including inheritance and applicability of statutes, documents, and instruments, whether executed before or after entry of this Final Judgment of Adoption, that do not expressly exclude the child from their operation or effect. The adoption of the child, AAA by BBB and CCC is hereby final.
